## ATTACHMENT A LOCATIONS TO BE SEARCHED

## A. John Cross Fish Market



The premises located at the address known as 209 Belvedere Avenue. Charlevoix, Michigan 49720, including the curtilage thereof. This location is more fully described as a two story building with white horizontal siding. There is a large picture style window in the center of the building with a door on each side of the window. The door on the right (as viewed from the driveway) is labeled "For staff only". The door on the left is the customer entrance. There is a brick chimney on the roof, centered above the picture window. There is a large sign shaped like a fish above and to the left of the customer entrance door. The sign is white and the fish has green fins. On the fish is written "The John Cross Fish Market". There is a row of windows on the lower level facing the street and a row of windows on the second floor. The business is located approximately .21 miles East of US 31. The business is located on the left side of the road as you are heading East on Belvedere Avenue. To reach the business from downtown Charlevoix, one would travel South on US 31 for .3 miles: one would then turn left on Belvedere Avenue for .2 miles; one would then turn left into the driveway of 209 Belvedere Avenue, Charlevoix, Michigan.





The premises located at the address known as 37992 Michigan Avenue, Beaver Island, Michigan 49782, including the curtilage thereof and any outbuilding or vehicles located thereon. The premises contain a one (1) story building with blue and gray siding, a white metal roof, and a covered porch over the front door. Approximately 20 yards west of the front door is a large white sign with "Beaver Island Fresh Fish Market" written on it. The business is located approximately .25 miles South of Lake Drive. The business is located on the left side of the road as you are heading South on Michigan Avenue. To reach the business from the Beaver Island Ferry Dock, one would travel East on Main Street for .6 miles; one would then continue straight as Main Street turns into Michigan Avenue for .3 miles; one would then turn left into the driveway of 37992 Michigan Avenue, Beaver Island, Michigan.
