The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT 1

(Assaulting, Resisting, or Impeding a Federal Officers with a Dangerous Weapon)

On or about August 22, 2015, in Chippewa County, in the Northern Division of the

Western District of Michigan, the defendant,

ERIC MICHAEL VERWIEBE,

did, by means and use of a dangerous weapon, that is, a knife, forcibly assault, resist, oppose, impede and interfere with Bay Mills Tribal Police Officers Michael Parish and Brent Aikens, federal law enforcement officers, while they were engaged in the performance of their official duties, by threatening to kill the officers and brandishing the knife.
