

# WANTED

Do you know what happened to Adam Campbell?



**Death investigation:** At 3:30 a.m. on Saturday, April 9, 2011, Escanaba Department of Public Safety firefighters discovered the body of Adam Gerald Campbell, 26, in a burning vehicle parked near a residence in the 300 block of South 19th Street in Escanaba, Michigan.



**Last seen:** Adam was last seen leaving a tavern in the 1100 block of Ludington Street and walking west on the sidewalk at 2:30 a.m. on Saturday, April 9, 2011.

**Information needed:** If you have any information regarding the circumstances surrounding the death of Adam Campbell, please contact Detective/Lieutenant Darin Hunter, either directly via the Escanaba Department of Public Safety, or anonymously via Crime Stoppers.

**Reward for tips:** Up to a \$6,000\* reward is being offered for information leading to an arrest or conviction.
