**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXPEDITED
HEARING ON STIPULATED MOTION TO ASSUME
LEASES OR EXECUTORY CONTRACTS**

This matter comes before the court on the Debtor's Motion for an Expedited Hearing to Assume Lease of Executory Contracts with the City of Marquette [Dkt. No. 199] (the "Motion to Shorten") filed by Young Mens Christian Association of Marquette County (the "Debtor"). The Motion to Shorten seeks to reduce the notice period in connection with the Debtor's Stipulated Motion for Order Authorizing Debtor to Assume Lease *Nunc Pro Tunc* to Petition Date and to Enter into Restated Lease Agreement with the City of Marquette [Dkt. No. 197] (the "Motion") separately filed by the Debtor.

The court has reviewed the Motion to Shorten and finds that a hearing is unnecessary. The Motion to Shorten demonstrates cause for reduction of the notice period as required by Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006(c) and LBR 9013(h), but not to the extent requested by the Debtor. *Compare* LBR 9013(g) (emergency hearing in less than seven days) *with* LBR 9013(h) (expedited hearing that is not emergency).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Motion to Shorten is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a telephonic hearing on the Motion shall be held on November 27, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. (Eastern). To participate in the telephonic hearing, please dial 888-808-6929 and reference Access Code 5148511.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the telephonic hearing may be recorded from the moment the first participant accesses the line, even if an operator or the court fails to announce the commencement of recording.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Debtor shall serve a copy of this Order, the Motion and all documents related thereto upon the matrix via first class mail by no later than November 13, 2017.
